OAA, INC. Announces 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Events Calendar August 22<sup>nd</sup> -30<sup>th</sup> designated for commemoration festivities

**Gardena, CA--(May 4, 2009)** The Okinawa Association of America, Inc. (OAA) is pleased to announce its centennial events calendar. The commemoration activities will kick off with a memorial service on August 22, 2009, at the OAA Center in Gardena, California. The following weekend, August 27<sup>th</sup> through the 30<sup>th</sup>, is slated for the main festival.

The theme for this year is "Ichi Nu Ichimadin," which means, "From Generation to Generation" (in the Okinawan dialect). Lectures, entertainment and other events have been planned throughout the year to highlight this theme.

"We would like our Okinawan brothers and sisters and all Okinawans at heart to join us in celebrating this milestone," said Chogi Higa, 2009 OAA President, "We chose Ichi Nu Ichimadin as our theme because it reflects the history and growth of our organization as we have descendents from our Issei (first generation) pioneers in our diverse membership as well as generations of families from all over the world who share a tie to Okinawa."

Among the distinctive events during the festival, will be an "exclusive" musical incorporating modern, up-tempo music into an ancient Okinawan story. Director Daiichi Hirata, of Okinawa, is creating this unique show about Okinawa's first king, King Sho Hashi. Mr. Hirata's artistic talents have garnered acclaim from people of all ages in Okinawa and Hawaii.

The anniversary banquet and outdoor cultural festival, Bunka-sai, will feature Okinawan music, dance and martial arts. Lectures on Okinawan identity will examine the history of the community and current generational issues.
