**Los Angeles Tea Festival by Chado • 11AM – 5PM**

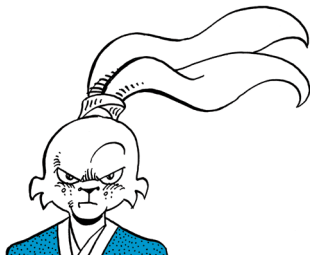
