

One of the filmmakers of The Manzanar Fishing Club, producer/director Cory Shiozaki will visit the JCl to discuss the film and relate it to specific connections in the local community. Cameraman-turned-director Cory Shiozaki is a 31-year member of the International Cinematographers Guild. He is a third-generation (sansei) Japanese-American whose parents were among the 120,000 evacuees who were rounded up in the immediate aftermath of Pearl Harbor.

"My mother and father always were reluctant to discuss such a painful chapter in their lives," Shiozaki says, "and I vowed that someday I would make a film about the internment as a reminder that something like this must never happen again." He will show excerpts from the movie and weave them into a presentation on the issues and history of the Day of Remembrance.
